

**GREAT BOWLS OF FIRE
CHILI CHAMPIONSHIP COOK OFF**

Saturday, October 8, 2011– Downtown DeLand, FL on East Indiana Avenue

RULES TO FOLLOW

ALL COOKS MUST PROVIDE A **MINIMUM OF THREE (3) GALLONS OF CHILI FOR PUBLIC TASTING AT 11:00 A.M. WHEN GATES OPEN.**

NOTE: WITH A LARGER CROWD EXPECTED AT THIS YEAR'S EVENT, THE MORE CHILI YOU CAN BRING THE BETTER CHANCE YOU HAVE OF NOT RUNNING OUT BEFORE THE JUDGING IS OVER

Each cook stand is required by local fire codes to have a 5-pound 2 A40-BC fire extinguisher.

OPEN Competition: Open chili may be prepared in advance of the event, and is expected to be served to the public. **There are no restrictions on beans or fillers**

SHOWMANSHIP Competition: Dress up yourself and/or your booth and win a prize! Judging will be made by a Local Celebrity Panel of Judges.

ALL COOKS: Set up is October 8, 2011, starting at 7:00AM to 10:00AM. Cooks will meet at 10:00AM at the Judges' Table to register their chili for the Cook Off and receive their supplies and signs. ***Do not leave vehicles unattended. All vehicles must be removed from the event area by 10:00AM.***

- ***IMPORTANT:** ***City health codes require all cooks to have three 5-gallon buckets for washing cooking utensils. Bring soap, disinfectant***
